Stamkos Thriving Under New Coach

When interim coach Rick Tocchet replaced Barry Melrose last Friday, one of the things Tocchet wanted to do was get Steven Stamkos more ice time. Under Barry Melrose, Stamkos never played more than 15 minutes in a game, was averaging a little less than 12 minutes a game and failed to reach the 10-minute mark of ice time in five games, including Melrose?s last on Nov. 13.

John Tavares, who was not surprisingly named the top OHL prospect for the 2009 Entry Draft when Central Scouting released its Preliminary Rankings earlier this week, may not be with the Oshawa Generals much longer.
